Dear parents/ carers,

I hope you are all well and safe. It has been a strange and unsettling time over the last few months and all the staff have missed everyone greatly.

Unfortunately, we will be unable to open up to more year groups before the Summer holidays. All the staff who are available to work in school at the moment are in a 'Bubble' with specific children and unable to mix with other bubbles of children.

I will write to everyone ASAP, after the final guidelines for schools comes out for September. Working on what we know so far, we hope to get all the children back in school for a minimum of 80% of the week, if not more. This may mean using both sites for a short time, if social distancing is still in place in the classroom.

In the meantime, I thought I would inform you of some changes and the class teachers for next year.

The children in Y4/5/6 from St Margaret's will continue to be taught alongside the All Saints children. This decreases each year as a new year group stays at the St Margaret's site.

Miss Hammersley, who is a qualified teacher and who currently works for the 'Federation' as a Teaching Assistant, will be taking up the role of our Year 2/3 teacher at All Saints, from September. Miss Hammersley was the successful candidate when interviewed and we know she will be an asset to the school's teaching staff.
